Toronto shot *Queer as Folk* is about the lives of a group of gay men and women living in Pittsburgh who, like anyone, are focused on their relationships, careers, loves and ambitions. The series is a realistic, funny and sometimes graphic portrayal of a minority community living in present-day society. It's not West Hollywood, it's not the Castro and it's not Chelsea. It may be a small world -- a gay Main Street with a couple of bars, a disco, a few shops and a diner -- but its reverberations are universal. *Queer as Folk* is an unapologetic celebration of life in its varied forms. And as always, in the differences we discover the similarities that make us all human. Seasons 3 and 4 air in 2009.
